Mr. NGUYEN MANH DZUNG

Mr. Nguyen Manh Dzung is the founding chairman of Dzungsrt & Associates LLC, with over 30 years of experience in the field of international commercial dispute resolution. He is currently an independent arbitrator at ADR Vietnam Chambers LLC. Mr. Dzung was directly involved in drafting and editing the 2010 Commercial Arbitration Law, Decree 22/CP on Commercial Mediation, as well as the 2015 Civil Procedure Code regarding the recognition and enforcement of foreign arbitral awards and the recognition of out-of-court mediation agreements. These efforts helped create the legal framework for the development of arbitration and commercial mediation in Viet Nam. He is currently an arbitrator at VIAC (Viet Nam), KCAB International (South Korea), HIAC and SHAC (China), and HKIAC (Hong Kong). Attorney Nguyen Manh Dzung adjudicates disputes related to consultancy contracts, services, supply, agency, distribution, international sales of goods, loan contracts, lease contracts, joint venture agreements, business cooperation agreements, maritime cargo transport contracts, ship charter contracts, maritime insurance contracts, mergers and acquisitions (M&A), and more. He also serves as a guest lecturer on Arbitration and Mediation and is invited as an expert researcher by international organizations to enhance the capacity of judicial bodies in Viet Nam. He has been a speaker at various academic forums.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tran Viet Dzung is currently the Vice Rector of Ho Chi Minh City University of Law (HCMUL). He also teaches LLM Programmes of the University of West England, Jean Moulin University Law School, Montesquieu University of Bordeaux, Chulalongkorn University; visiting professor for the Graduate Institute of International Studies (IHEI) of Panthéon-Assas University Paris; member of Editorial Board of the Kutafin Law Review (KuLAWR) and Vietnamese Journal of Legal Sciences (VJLS). He worked as senior research fellow of Tallinn Technology University (2018–2022). His academic focus spans international investment, international trade, M&A, ISDS, investment and sustainable development, technology and law. Mr. Dzung combines academic knowledge with practical experience as an international lawyer. He currently functions as the secretary of Working Group III on Investor-State Dispute Settlement Reform and has served as secretary of working groups on dispute settlement, secured transactions and electronic commerce.

Before joining the United Nations in 2007, Jae Sung served in the Korean Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Jae Sung is a graduate of Seoul National University College of Law, holds LL.M. degrees from Seoul National University Graduate School of International Studies and NYU School of Law as well as a Ph.D. in Law from Seoul National University.

With more than 20 years of experience in law development at the Ministry of Justice, Ms. Van Anh has directly participated in drafting and appraising many legal documents related to investment and trade: the Law on Investment in the form of public-private partnerships; Law on Foreign Trade Management; Law on Bidding, etc. In the area of international integration, Ms. Van Anh has participated in negotiation numerous international treaties in investment, economic and trade; particularly Comprehensive Progressive Tran Pacific Partnership Agreement (CPTPP); Viet Nam – EU Free Trade Agreement; Viet Nam – EU Investment Protection Agreement; Viet Nam – UK Free Trade Agreement ... Regarding foreign investments, Ms. Van Anh has participated in establishment of numerous foreign investment projects; handling difficulties of foreign investors; participating in negotiation of investment contracts such as BOT contracts on Power Plants (BOT contracts, Government Guarantee and Undertaking; granting Legal Opinion on BOT project documents ...). In the field of dispute settlement, Ms. Van Anh currently leads a specialized team in the Ministry of Justice representing the Government, Government Agencies in Investor – State disputes and has directly involved in a number of complicated cases. Dr. Nguyen Thi Hoa has been a lecturer at international law faculty of Ho Chi Minh city University of law in Vietnam since September 2019, where she researches and teaches in English as well as French the subjects related to notablely international business law, international commercial arbitration law, international commercial contract negotiation and drafting skill and laws regarding application of digital technology. In addition, since April 2022, she has been also a reviewer for the Journal of Legal Affairs and Dispute Resolution in Engineering and Construction (indexed on Scopus – 1st quartile in 2020–2024) of the American Society of Civil Engineering. Currently, she is also a member of the Executive Committee of the Society of Construction Law in Viet Nam.
